## Steps to Add & Subtract Decimals

<u>Step 1</u>: Re-write the question and line up the numbers so that the largest number is on top. Place Value is very important so you must make sure the numbers are lined up in the proper place and that the decimals are all lined up under each other.

EX: 1.23 + 6.4 + 2.007 would be re-written as follows

**Step 2**: Add 0's as place holders where necessary. This is especially important when subtracting decimals.

**Step 3**: Add or subtract like you would whole numbers. Be sure to include the decimal in your answer.

6.400 2.007 + 1.230 9.637
